Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

- 1) Material should be as per our enquiry and if we found any damage or deviation material will be returned back for replacement and subsequently incident will be raised. - 2) **Payment terms: 60 days for MSME(MANUFACTURER) and NON MSME - 90days .Bidder should upload the Proper registered MSE (UDYAM REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE)**
- 3) **Material Test Certificate is mandatory should be sent along with the supply. The material will be checked by our inspection Without test certificate material will not be accepted for AISI 316 and where ever seamless mentioned should be seamless Third party inspection certificate required**
- 4) **If you have any query filling the tender please call me at 9112253747 or message me if not picking the call**
- 5) **After inspection if we found deviation material will be returned.**
- 6) **Seal and sign should be there in tender documents and condition failing to provide will be disqualified.**
- 7) **If we found any deviation in any technical evaluation supplier will be subject to disqualification.**
- 8) **Buyer reserves the right to increase or decrease the material quantity after finalization of order for 6 months without any additional cost implication. So please quote according to the clause.**
- 9) **Bidder should not be under liquidation, court receiver ship, similar proceeding should not be bankrupt.**
- 10) **Liquidated damage / penalty for late delivery: in the event of delay in delivery of material supply / penalty at the rate of ½ % of the total value of each week of delay will be levied up to 5% and recovered for incomplete / undeveloped material.**
- 11) **Validity: The offer should remain valid as per GEM Tender enquiry.**
- 12) **Delivery schedule : immediate**
- 13) **Commercial : Price to Remain firm till the execution of contract and Rate Quoted should be for Destination basis upto HMT Aurangabad inclusive of packing , freight and insurance and GST as per GEM GTC**
- 14) **MSE preference if any to be uploaded at the time of bid submission for verification & availing MSE purchase preference. (Vendor should apply for MSE purchase preference at the time of Bid Submission, if not applied shall not be given any MSE purchase preference as per GeM rule).**
- 15) **EVALUATION SHALL BE ON Individual item L1 BASIS.**
- 16) **Rate should be fair.**
- 17) **NO offline submission from the bidder is required , Only through GEM PORTAL**
- 18) **Material is most urgent for Production.**

3. **Bid reserved for MSE from the State of Bid Inviting Authority:** Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Micro and Small Enterprises from the State of Bid Inviting Authority having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the reservation benefit, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible to participate in this bid. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility based on

documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
5. Material Test Certificate Should Be Sent Along with The Supply. The Material Will Be Checked by Buyer's Lab & the Results of the Lab will be the Sole Criteria for Acceptance of the Item.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
